

SCU-50 Splash Housing

FULLY open the zip of the splash housing

Attach the camera bridge plate on to the camera

Gently ease the camera, lens and accessories into the housing

Locate the camera bridge plate into the internal dovetail plate and position the lens as close to the front port as possible

Do not force any part of this operation, or put any stress on the zip ends

FULLY CLOSE THE ZIP, ensuring the slider seats fully into the end of the zip

To remove the camera, reverse these steps

To insert connectors, simply push on the body. **Connector plugs and caps must be mated when underwater.** Failure to do so will lead to the connectors filling with water when the caps are re-installed after use



When connecting or disconnecting the cables **grip the connector bodies**. Do **not** pull on the cables, as this will damage the connector assembly

With the camera enclosed in the splash housing the unit has positive buoyancy. However, the housing can be submerged by letting out some air from the housing by rotating the adjustable dump valve anticlockwise. Air will vent from the valve as the unit submerges. For greater depth rotate the valve further

If using the external base plate, ensure the securing screws protrude NO LONGER THAN 3/8" (9.5mm)

Care Instructions

Before every use, inspect the housing for visible damage. For total safety, it is recommended to fully close the zip and submerge the empty unit for 10 minutes. Inspect for leaks after this period

Handle carefully at all times

Avoid contact with sharp or pointed objects
Store in a cool place
Do not fold the housing when stored
Do not leave the housing for long periods in direct sunlight

After every use:

- Wash the housing off with fresh water
- Clean the inside and outside of the front port with the glass cleaner
 - Recoat the front port with the non-stick polymer provided
- Clean the zip, treat it with the zip care solution, and lubricate it with zip wax

SCUBACAM SPLASH HOUSINGS ARE TESTED TO BE WATERTIGHT TO A MAXIMUM DEPTH OF **4 METRES**.

DO NOT LEAVE UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME WHILST UNDERWATER
